In case you missed the email over the Christmas Break, several members of our school community are deserved of special thank yous for their recent generosity:

- On the last day of classes before Christmas Break, the 5th-8th Grade Home Room Teachers and Religion, Science, Spanish, and Technology Teachers were informed that iPads have been ordered for them! This was made possible through the generous giving of School Advisory Board member and parent, Deb Moreland, who donated \$800 and several 5th-8th grade parents who contributed \$1,025. Our PTA will use our fundraising dollars to pay any remaining balance on the 8 iPads. The teacher iPads will help our teachers to drive their classroom instruction. As early as August 2019, we plan to equip our Middle School students with their own iPads to enrich their experience at St. Patrick and to prepare them for high school and beyond.
