St. Paul tells the Thessalonians: "Stand firm and hold fast to the traditions you were taught, either by an oral statement or by a letter of ours" (2 Thessalonians 2:15). Tradition doesn't mean "old customs"—it means the lived teachings of Christ passed down through the apostles and their successors.

Together, Scripture and Tradition form one sacred deposit of faith. Just like a river needs both banks to flow clearly, our understanding of God's Word is most full when guided by both.
