A national Catholic celebration marking the 250th anniversary of the United States begins here in the Diocese of St. Augustine.

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage will launch May 24–25 from the National Shrine of Our Lady of La Leche, with special events at the Shrine May 22–23 drawing visitors from across the country. This is a unique opportunity to welcome the wider Church and invite others into an encounter with Christ in the Eucharist.

Next Sunday May 17, His Excellency Most Rev. Eric Pohlmeier, Bishop of Saint Augustine, will visit our parish to confer the Sacrament of Confirmation to our young people at the 10am Mass.

The new oil painting on the wall of the Blessed Mother Shrine, is a portrait of the Florida Martyrs. Many American Indians who voluntarily converted to the Catholic faith and many religious brothers and priests were martyred for the faith beginning in the 16th century. One such event occurred within our parish boundaries at Ft. George Island.

There is another oil painting commissioned for the opposite wall (St. Joseph) of the patron of our Diocese, Saint Augustine.

All interior enhancements to the beauty of our church (new wallpaper, ornamental iron around baptistry, new paintings) were obtained using gift money as well as grants.

The Blessed Sacrament is Exposed every Tuesday evening for your quiet prayer time from 6-7pm. Confessions available.

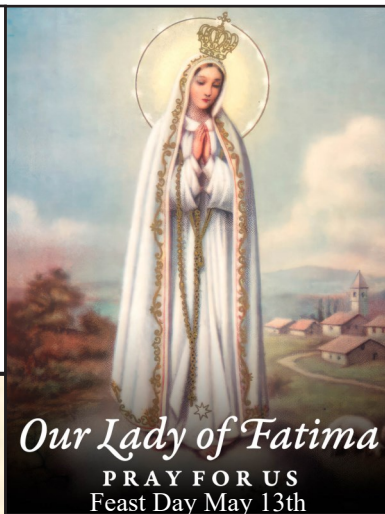


