**The Visitation Of Mary  
 Feast Day May 31**



Following the Annunciation, Mary travels to a city in Judah to visit her cousin Elizabeth. Upon Mary's greeting, the infant John the Baptist leaps in Elizabeth's womb, and Elizabeth, filled with the Holy Spirit, exclaims, "Most blessed are you among women, and blessed is the fruit of your womb". *Luke 1:39-56*

**Devil's Advocate** was an official position in the Catholic Church, formally known as the Promoter of the Faith. Established in 1587, this officer was tasked with arguing against the canonization of a saint, scrutinizing miracles, and finding flaws in the candidate's character to ensure the process was accurate. In 1983, Pope John Paul II dramatically reduced the power of, and changed the role of this office, streamlining the sainthood process.



Saint Justin Martyr (c. 100–165 AD) Saint Justin was a pivotal 2nd-century Christian apologist, philosopher, and martyr. He was born in Samaria to Greek parents. After studying various Greek philosophies, he converted to Christianity, arguing it was the only "sure and profitable philosophy". He was beheaded in Rome for refusing to sacrifice to pagan gods.
