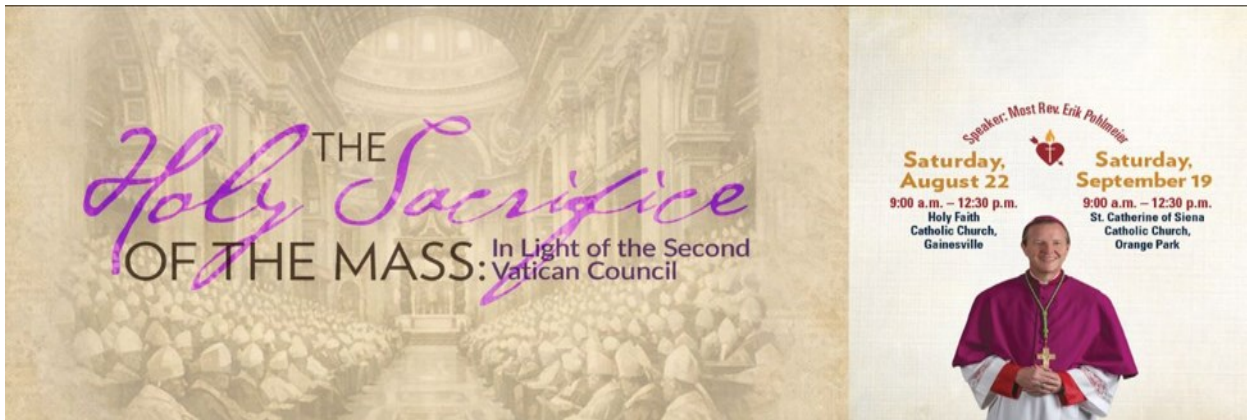

Bishop to lead workshops on a deeper understanding of the Mass

Bishop Erik Pohlmeier will lead two free workshops this fall, *The Holy Sacrifice of the Mass: In Light of the Second Vatican Council*, inviting clergy and laity to deepen their understanding of the Eucharist and the Church's call to full, conscious and active participation in the Sacred Mysteries. Workshop topics include the shape of the sacrifice, the role of the assembly and priest, participation in the liturgy, and the importance of silence and reverence.

The workshops will be held from 9 a.m. to 12:30 p.m. Saturday, Aug. 22, at Holy Faith Catholic Church in Gainesville and Saturday, Sept. 19, at St. Catherine of Siena Catholic Church in Orange Park. Sponsored by the diocesan Liturgical Commission, the workshops are free, open to all and no registration is required.

The month of July is dedicated to the Precious Blood. The feast of the Precious Blood of our Lord was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity. The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood.

The Precious Blood which we worship is the Blood which the Savior shed for us on Calvary and reassumed at His glorious Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses through the veins of His risen, glorified, living body at the right hand of God the Father in heaven; it is the Blood made present on our altars by the words of Consecration; it is the Blood which merited sanctifying grace for us and through it washes and beautifies our soul and inaugurates the beginning of eternal life in it.

Remember, when we received the consecrated host at communion, we are receiving the body, **blood**, soul and divinity of Our Lord.

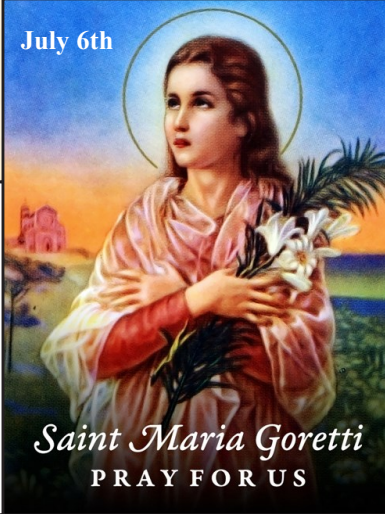
