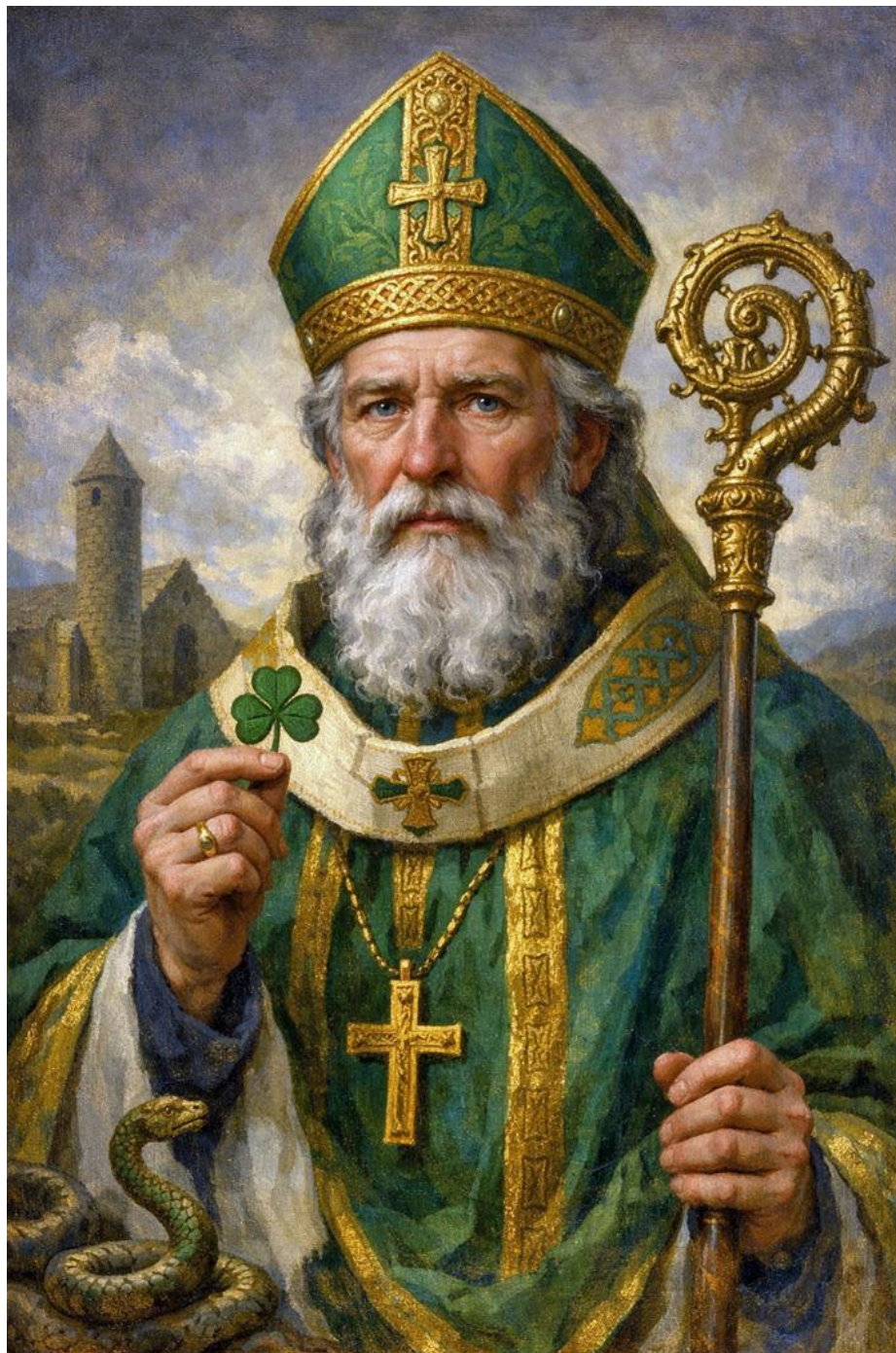

The Window on Death Row Film Screening and Discussion

The Office of Prison Ministry invites the faithful to a special screening of *The Window on Death Row* on Wednesday, Aug. 5, from 6-8 p.m. at the Bishop Baker Center adjacent to the Cathedral Parish School, 267 St. George St., St. Augustine.

Bishop Erik Pohlmeier will offer opening remarks before the film, followed by a panel discussion with prison ministry volunteers and advocates exploring the Church's teaching on mercy, justice, redemption and the dignity of every human person. The event provides an opportunity to reflect on the Catholic response to the death penalty and the Gospel call to uphold the sanctity of all human life.

Admission is free, and all are welcome.

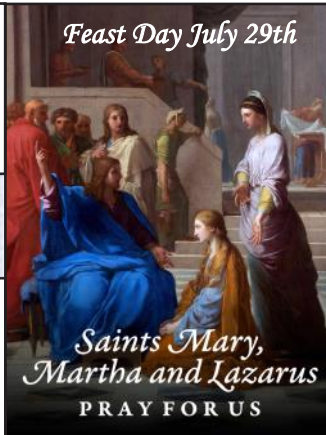
