September 12**Celebrate St. Augustine Founders' Day**

Celebrate the founding of St. Augustine and give thanks for the gift of the Catholic faith, first brought to these shores in 1565. The celebration begins at 10 a.m. at Mission Nombre de Dios with a historical reenactment, followed by Mass with Bishop Pohlmeier at the Rustic Altar and a procession to the Fountain of Youth. On the Feast Day of St. Augustine, August 28th, the artist delivered the completed oil painting of the patron of our Diocese— Saint Augustine. It is hanging on the wall of the shrine of St. Joseph. It's the same artists who painted the portrait of the Florida martyrs hung on Our Lady's Shrine. Both paintings were commissioned using grant money from a foundation— to add beauty and history to our church building.

Holy Communion

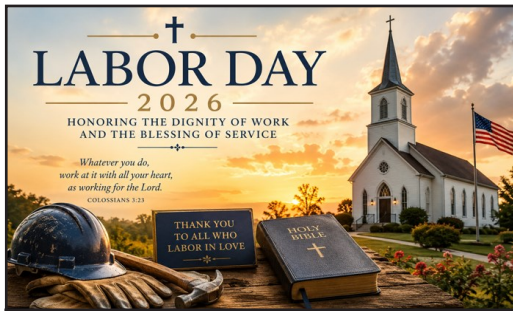

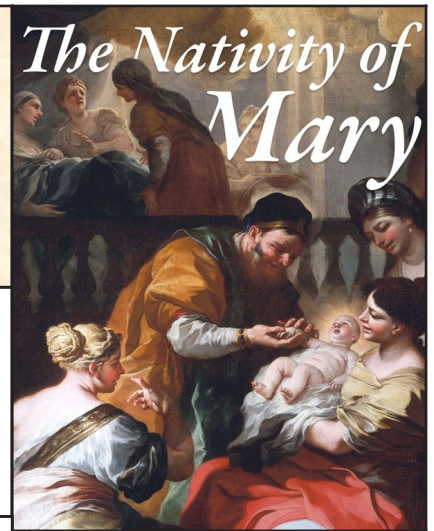
