Step Up for Students - Florida Private School Scholarship

Students, regardless of household income, who are residents of Florida and eligible to enroll in a K-12 public school, can receive a scholarship to attend a private school that best meets their needs. These scholarships are available through the Florida Tax Credit Scholarship Program (FTC) and the Family Empowerment Scholarship for Educational Options (FES-EO).

All families who receive the Florida Private School (FTC or FES-EO) Scholarship need to pay all balances not covered by the scholarship. A copy of the award letter is required before scholarship award will be applied toward tuition and fees. Go to www.stepupforstudents.org.

Step Up for Students – Family Empowerment (FES-UA) Scholarship (formerly Gardiner Scholarship)

The Family Empowerment Scholarship for Students with Unique Abilities (FES-UA) enables families to personalize the education of their students by directing funds to where they're needed most.

All families who receive the FES-UA Scholarship (formerly Gardiner Scholarship) must provide school office with Family ID, issued by Step Up, before scholarship award will be applied toward tuition and fees. Go to www.stepupforstudents.org

AAA Scholarship

The parent and child(ren) must be baptized Catholic, and a registered and contributing member of a Catholic Church. * Non-St. Patrick Parishioners must provide a signed letter from their pastor confirming they attend regularly. Eligibility and scholarship amounts are determined by the financial office in consultation with the principal and pastor.
